

Introduction

This page surveys the plethora of Hebrew Names and Titles for God the Son, *Yeshua Hamashiach*, as found in the *Brit Chadashah*. They are listed in alphabetical order, with the Hebrew spelling, common transliteration, and English phonetics following. For each Name, I include some Scriptural references.

After reading through this list, you should be awestruck at the amount of direct revelation we have been given that Yeshua HaMashiach is indeed God the Son!

A Note about the Hebrew and Greek Texts for the Son's Names

The New Testament was written in Koine Greek, of course, and that's the starting point for serious exegesis of its writings. The Hebrew names derived here come from the Salkinson-Ginsburg Hebrew New Testament (1999 edition) which I compared to F. Delitzsch's older Hebrew translation of the Brit Chadashah as well as with the Robinson-Pierpont Majority Text (1995), the Westcott and Hort NT, and the Friberg NT (UBS3/4). I also cross-checked against the LXX and various Jewish sources.

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
