Errors

- 1. Well developed premise/faulty foundation
- 2. Correct/incorrect principles:
 - 1. Real and serious examples of governmental overreach, corruption and abuse are daily headlines. While the liberal agenda is to ferment lawlessness by creating the problem and them promoting false solutions, just the legitimate concerns raised conservative sources are enormous. Even from a strictly human standpoint, reasons for concern abound.
 - 2. Unbelievable governmental waist is another correct assertion by libertarians and even anarchist. Again, the systemic nature of

such obvious flaws reveal serious if not fatal failures that demand immediate recognition and remedy. Yet replacing bad government with no government would be leaping out of the frying pan into the fire.

3. Life, liberty and pursuit of happiness: Declaration of Independence P2: We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.--That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed, -- That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and accordingly all experience hath shewn, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such Government, and to provide new Guards for their future security.

4. Greatest truth?

1. Hardy. Outside of a few basic premises not actually socially or spiritually true at all.

5. Authority illegitimate and illusory.

- 1. The opposite is true both socially and spiritually.
- 2. The basis for all human society. (See point 6 below).
- 3. The basis for all spiritually life throughout eternity (See Bible, Eternity...The Wager, etc...)
 - 1. For Yours is the Kingdom, Power and Glory forever. Lord's Prayer
 - 2. Each of these Living Beings had six wings, and the central sections of their wings were covered with eyes. Day after day and night after night they kept on saying, "Holy, holy,

Lord God Almighty—the one who was, and is, and is to come." And when the Living Beings gave glory and honor and thanks to the one sitting on the throne, who lives forever and ever, the twenty-four Elders fell down before him and worshiped him, the Eternal Living One, and cast their crowns before the throne, singing, "O Lord, you are worthy to receive the glory and the honor and the power, for you have created all things. They were created and called into being by your act of will." Rev 4:8-11 LB

- 3. The seventh Angel trumpeted. A crescendo of voices in Heaven sang out, The kingdom of the world is now the Kingdom of our God and his Messiah! He will rule forever and ever. The Twenty-four Elders seated before God on their thrones fell to their knees, worshiped, and sang, We thank you, O God, Sovereign-Strong, Who Is and Who Was. You took your great power and took over—reigned! The angry nations now get a taste of *your* anger. The time has come to judge the dead, to reward your servants, all prophets and saints, Reward small and great who fear your Name, and destroy the destroyers of earth. Rev 11:15-18 MSG
- 4. Government authority from God.
 - 1. Be a good citizen. All governments are under God. Insofar as there is peace and order, it's God's order. So live responsibly as a citizen. If you're irresponsible to the state, then you're irresponsible with God, and God will hold you responsible. Duly constituted authorities are only a threat if you're trying to get by with something. Decent citizens should have nothing to fear. Rom 13:1-3 MSG
- 5. Pray for not overthrow government authorities.
 - 1. The first thing I want you to do is pray. Pray every way you know how, for everyone you know. Pray especially for rulers and their governments to rule well so we can be quietly about our business of living simply, in humble contemplation. This is the way our Savior God wants us to live. 1 Tim 2:1-3 MSG
- 6. Human nature basically good without government interference.

- 1. The opposite is true both socially and spiritually, with the caveat that human government has the basic social flaws cited above in Government 101 (power corrupts and absolute power corrupts absolutely).
 - 1. The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it? Jer 17:9 NIV
 - 2. I know I am rotten through and through so far as my old sinful nature is concerned. No matter which way I turn I can't make myself do right. I want to but I can't. When I want to do good, I don't; and when I try not to do wrong, I do it anyway. Now if I am doing what I don't want to, it is plain where the trouble is: sin still has me in its evil grasp. Romans 7:18-20 LB
- 2. Humanity fallen moral agents, casualties of a Heavenly Cosmic Battle raging across Three Heavens that has altered the History of Eternity and controls that of mankind through Conflict Theology.

7. Human free will sufficient.

- 1. Free will only Omnity's prerogative.
- 2. Mankind has Extremely Fleeting and Limited will corrupted by Three Fronts:
 - 1. The Bible explains that both personally, and as a species, mankind faces the deadly foe of sin on three fronts. Sin within, resulting from individual and inherited fallen natures. Sin above, in the form of devilish and demonic temptation and deception. And Sin about, the collective and cumulative effect of sin within and above.

8. Mankind is basically moral.

- 1. See points 5,6 and 7 above.
- 2. Where do you think all these appalling wars and quarrels come from? Do you think they just happen? Think again. They come about because you want your own way, and fight for it deep inside yourselves. You lust for what you don't have and are willing to kill to get it. You want what isn't yours and will risk violence to get your hands on it. You wouldn't think of just asking God for it, would you? And why not? Because you know you'd be asking for what you have no right to. You're spoiled children, each wanting your own way. You're cheating on God. If

all you want is your own way, flirting with the world every chance you get, you end up enemies of God and his way. And do you suppose God doesn't care? The proverb has it that "he's a fiercely jealous lover." And what he gives in love is far better than anything else you'll find. It's common knowledge that "God goes against the willful proud; God gives grace to the willing humble. James 4:1-6 MSG

- 3. Before every man there lies a wide and pleasant road that seems right but ends in death. Prov 14:12 LB
- 4. Someone asked him, "Lord, are only a few people going to be saved?" He said to them, "Make every effort to enter through the narrow door, because many, I tell you, will try to enter and will not be able to. Once the owner of the house gets up and closes the door, you will stand outside knocking and pleading, 'Sir, open the door for us.' "But he will answer, 'I don't know you or where you come from.' "Then you will say, 'We ate and drank with you, and you taught in our streets.' "But he will reply, 'I don't know you or where you come from. Away from me, all you evildoers!' "There will be weeping there, and gnashing of teeth... Luke 13:23-28 NIV

9. Human government illegitimate and illusory.

- 1. "World's problems solved overnight if we just let go so 'Santa Clause.'
 - 1. Ridiculously simplistic and incorrect.
- 2. See point 5 above.
- 3. Government is simply the way human society interacts.
- 4. "Employer-Employee vastly better than Government."
 - 1. Based on same principle only vastly more complicated.
 - 2. <u>Government (Societal relationship rules) necessary for the exchange of all goods and services since leaving hunter gatherer and farming economies.</u>

10. Taxes are the problem.

- 1. Taxes are A Big Problem to be sure.
 - 1. Over taxation
 - 2. Corruption
 - 3. Welfare state
 - 4. Misuse of funds (Global expansionism)
 - 5. Vast military budget (overspending and unjust wars)

- 2. "Taxes are an illegitimate, immoral form of financial slavery."
 - 1. There is little or no equivalent of current taxation to actual slavery.
 - 1. The average 1st world citizen has the equivalent of 1,000 person slaves.
 - 2. Freedom's enjoyed today far exceed those of all humanity throughout previous generations.
 - 2. To the degree they are applied appropriately, taxes are the most efficient way of improving modern society.
 - 1. Current corrupt policies have largely enabled the technological revolution and information age.
 - 3. Scripture's instructions regarding Slavery Itself (barbaric beyond belief) reveal God's insistence on recognizing the importance of authority:
 - 1. 1 Tim 1:10: fornicators, sodomites, slave traders, liars, perjurers, and whatever else is contrary to the sound teaching.
 - 2. Rom 7:25: Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God's law, but in my sinful nature a slave to the law of sin.
 - 3. 1 Cor 7:20-22: Each person should remain in the situation they were in when God called them. Were you a slave when you were called? Don't let it trouble you—although if you can gain your freedom, do so. For the one who was a slave when called to faith in the Lord is the Lord's freed person; similarly, the one who was free when called is Christ's slave.
 - 4. Eph 6:5-8: Slaves, obey your earthly masters with fear and trembling, in singleness of heart, as you obey Christ; not only while being watched, and in order to please them, but as slaves of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart. Render service with enthusiasm, as to the Lord and not to men and women, knowing that whatever good we do, we will receive the same again from the Lord, whether we are slaves or free.
 - 5. Eph 6:9 And, masters, do the same to them. Stop threatening them, for you know that both of you have the

- same Master in heaven, and with him there is no partiality.
- 6. Col 3:22-24 Slaves, obey your earthly masters in everything, not only while being watched and in order to please them, but wholeheartedly, fearing the Lord. Whatever your task, put yourselves into it, as done for the Lord and not for your masters, since you know that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward; you serve the Lord Christ.
- 7. 1 Tim 6:1-2: Let all who are under the yoke of slavery regard their masters as worthy of all honor, so that the name of God and the teaching may not be blasphemed. Those who have believing masters must not be disrespectful to them on the ground that they are members of the church; rather they must serve them all the more, since those who benefit by their service are believers and beloved. Teach and urge these duties.
- 8. 1 Peter 2:18 Slaves, accept the authority of your masters with all deference, not only those who are kind and gentle but also those who are harsh.
- 9. Titus 2:9-10: Tell slaves to be submissive to their masters and to give satisfaction in every respect; they are not to talk back, not to pilfer, but to show complete and perfect fidelity, so that in everything they may be an ornament to the doctrine of God our Savior.

- 2. Ruler and God of this world
 - 1. The devil led him up to a high place and showed him in an instant all the kingdoms of the world. And he said to him, "I will give you all their authority and splendor; it has been given to me, and I can give it to anyone I want to.Luke 4:5-6 NIV
 - 2. But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them. 2 Cor 4:4 NKJV
 - 3. Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will. 2 Tim 2:25-26 NIV
- 3. New World Order to create governmental and social crises on national and global scale.
- 4. Antichrist
 - 1. Man of sin
 - 2. Man of lawlessness
 - 3. Mark of the Beast introduced and globally mandated.
- 5. Apocalyptic Biblical prophecy
 - Reappearance and International's prominence of Israel amazing prophetic markers. The Alive After The Fall video is a short but well produced overview of last day prophecies in light of recent events. It also offers a

6. New Creations

- 1. Today's answer to Satanic and human misuse of authority.
 - 1. You are still worldly. For since there is jealousy and quarreling among you, are you not worldly? **Are you not acting like mere humans?** For when one says, "I follow Paul," and another, "I follow Apollos," **are you not mere human beings?**" 1 Corinthians 3:3-4 NIV
 - 2. There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. Galatians 3:26 NIV
 - 3. So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come. The old has gone, the new is here!" 2 Corinthians 5:16-17 NIV

7. Kingdom of God

- 1. The final answer to Satanic and human misuse of authority.
 - 1. May Your Kingdom come and will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Lord's Prayer
 - 2. Pilate went back into the palace and called for Jesus. He said, "Are you the 'King of the Jews'?" Jesus answered, "Are you saying this on your own, or did others tell you this about me?" Pilate said, "Do I look like a Jew? Your people and your high priests turned you over to me. What did you do?" "My kingdom," said Jesus, "doesn't consist of what you see around you. If it did, my followers would fight so that I wouldn't be handed over to the Jews. But I'm not that kind of king, not the world's kind of king." John 18:33-36 MSG
 - 3. The Kingdom of God is within you.
 - 1. One day the Pharisees asked Jesus, "When will the Kingdom of God begin?" Jesus replied, "The Kingdom

of God isn't ushered in with visible signs. You won't be able to say, 'It has begun here in this place or there in that part of the country.' For the Kingdom of God is within you." Luke 17:20-21 LB
